One Million Lights will match raised funds by 15% to provide more lights for your distribution and transform the lives of a rural community overnight. You will be entrusted with the solar lights to distribute to a community of your choice founded on a criterion that is fair, based on local need, and respects gender equality. Be on the ground and help others see the change that light can bring.

**Program Objective:**

The objective of the Global Ambassador Program, is to give you a unique opportunity to meet children and adults in a developing community and personally hand them solar lights. You are entrusted with lights to promote and educate about solar energy use, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and increase the opportunities for education, health and income generation in developing regions around the world. Thus, you will have the chance to personally improve the livelihood of a rural community in the developing world one solar light at a time.



**Program Description:**

The Global Ambassador Program of One Million Lights engages students and professionals to become ambassadors for providing clean and healthy lighting to under-resourced communities across



the world. One Million Lights matches fundraised funds by Global Ambassadors to increase distribution to communities in need around the world. Ambassadors are then entrusted with solar lights to distribute to a community of their choice founded on a criterion that is fair, based on local need, and respects gender equality. Lights are to be distributed and

documented by Ambassadors on a study abroad semester, vacation to a developing country, mission trip with a community group, or general travel. One Million Lights orders the lights and provides logistical support to get the lights to the Ambassadors in country or prior to travel. They also help promote Ambassador projects online through social media to help with fundraising.

**Most Often used Solar Lights- \$15 per light or \$30 Buy-One-Give-One:**

**Dlight S20 Lantern**



The Dlight S20 is designed to be extremely user-friendly and flexible. It can be carried, hung from the ceiling, or placed on any surface to illuminate the surrounding area. It provides up to 8 hours of light on a day's charge.

**Nokero 233**

The Nokero N233 is compact, light, and durable. It runs up to 15 hours on one day's charge. It has a low and a high setting. It can be hung, held, or placed on a surface.



\*\*\*One Million Lights is continuously testing new solar products and can help the Ambassadors determine what is the best light for your project. Many of our Ambassadors want bring solar lights that have cell phone chargers or want to bring solar room systems.



### **One Million Lights Commitment to the Ambassadors:**

- To work alongside Ambassadors to promote solar energy, reduce carbon emissions and increase the opportunities for education, health and income generation in developing regions.
- One Million Lights promises to match up to 15% of matched fundraised funds to increase the number of lights for distribution.
- To supply Ambassadors with logistics and marketing assistance.
- To provide Ambassadors with a webpage to promote their project and receive donations.

### **The Ambassador's Commitment to One Million Lights:**

- To support the organization's mission of providing clean and safe lighting to under-resourced communities in the developing world.
- To distribute solar lights established on a criterion that is fair, based on local need, and respects gender equality
- To document distribution of lights with photos, videos and stories



**Application Process/Timeline:** (Applications **MUST** be received eight weeks prior to departure.)

- I. Applicants submit a completed Application to One Million Lights
- II. Applicants will receive notification that a completed application has been received and is under review
- III. Follow Up email to help work out project details.
- IV. Selected Global Ambassadors fundraise and market their project.
- V. Global Ambassadors must submit the OML risk waiver prior to departure.
- VI. Before Departure, Ambassadors or their on-the-ground contact receive solar lights
- VII. Ambassadors document and distribute solar lights
- VIII. Ambassadors submit photos, videos and stories to OML and Thank you to Donors
